Introduction of Electronic Medical Health Record (EMHR) in the system



The operation of the EMHR in the hospital has commenced. To that effect, stakeholders from the clinical services and other related units were trained on the application. To

1.1 CLINICAL SERVICES

1.1.1 Residency Training

1.1.2 Know the Eight (8) Major Firms in the Clinical services at a glance

1.1.4 Clinical Conference, FNPHY

A pilot study on substitution therapy in substance use disorder patients was conducted at the clinical conference held recently by the stakeholders on the drug ward. It was presented with a theme, 'Debating the devil and the deep sea'.

1.1.5 Harvey Road Community Clinic

Currently, the hospital has two (2) Consultant Family Physicians at the Harvey Road Community clinic namely; Dr. A. M Adegbite and Dr. Faith Ibilola. An extension of the community clinic has been established at Oshodi annex of the hospital. Oshodi clinic opens on Tuesdays and Thursdays of every week while the clinic in Yaba still runs from Mondays to Fridays, 8a.m. to 4p.m. Minor surgeries are performed at the clinic together with other services like ECG on Tuesdays (9am-4pm) and Hepatitis vaccination.

Also, a locum Consultant Neurologist visits on Mondays between 9a.m and 11a.m. while a locum Consultant Cardiologist visits on Wednesdays between 3p.m and 5p.m in Yaba for now.



1.1.6 Psychology (group Therapy)

The Group therapy and relapse prevention programmes are on-going on the drug wards. Also, the therapy holds on other wards once in a week for substance patients.

1.1.7 Radiology

Management has acquired one (1) Akira mobile X-ray machine to improve Radiological services in the hospital.



1.1.8 Temporary movement of the Out Patient Clinic to Dinning hall

The Outpatient clinic has been temporarily moved to Patients Dinning hall due to the on-going construction work on the new OPC building. Consequently, Management has provided mobile toilets for the patients and relations convenience.

1.1.9 Return of Patients to MOB Wards

Following the renovation of the MOB wards, In-patients were temporarily relocated to the other wards.

However, the renovation work had been completed and patients had returned and settled in on the wards.

1.2 ADMINISTRATION

Staff Strength

The hospital has a total number of one thousand, two hundred and fifty seven (1257) regular staff on its nominal roll and two hundred and seventy seven (277) non-regular staff.

1.2.1 Staff Promotion

The staff promotion interview for the Senior Staff Category was held on the 29th and 30th April, 2023 in the hospital for members of staff in the clinical services and Administration department respectively. The outcome of the promotion interview produced three (3) Consultant specialists and four (4) Directors among others namely; Dr. (Mrs.) A. M Adegbite, Consultant (Family Physician) Special Grade 1, Dr. A. L Raji, Consultant (Psychiatrist) special Grade II, Dr.(Mrs).E Esangbedo, Consultant (Psychiatrist) special Grade II, Mrs. O. R Olowokandi, Director, Radiological services, Mr. O. O Ajayi, Director, Pharmaceutical Services, Mrs. O. A. Odufuwa, Director, Nursing Services and Mrs. Adebayo Adeola Oladunni, Director, Medical Laboratory services.

1.2.2 New Appointment

One hundred and twenty (120) new members of staff were employed in the last quarter of the year 2022 majorly in the clinical services. They had assumed duty accordingly.

1.2.3 Staff Identity Cards

The staff identity cards for the newly employed staff had been produced and distributed to their various departments for collection.

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1.2.4 Donations

The Chairman of FNPBY nurses in diaspora, Mr. Eboriame donated forty (40) mattresses for patients use on behalf of the nurses in diaspora.

Similarly, the family of late Raymond Agbo of Admiralty Estate, Alpha Beach donated ten thousand (₦10,000) naira for the patients while students from the University of Lagos, Akoka donated toiletries and books for the patients. All items donated had been handed over to the hospital gift Committee.



1.2.5 Construction work on the Administration Building

Due to the on-going construction work on the administration reception, the entrance has been closed temporarily while the emergency exit (opposite telephone room) has been opened for access into the building.

1.2.6 Training /Sponsorship

Five (5) members of staff were sponsored for different training programmes from January to May, 2023.

1.2.7 Waste Management

The Medical and domestic wastes from every disposal site were evacuated by Lagos State waste Management Authority (LAWMA)

1.2.8 National Health Insurance Authority (NHIA)

The national Health Insurance Authority (NHIA) under the National Health Act 2022 and formerly known as the National Health Insurance Scheme (NHIS) has a desk officer in the hospital. Intending enrollees should visit the NHIA office in the Administration building for necessary enquiry.

1.3 FEDERAL SCHOOL OF OCCUPATION THERAPY

The school has one hundred and ninety nine (199) students spread across its two (2) year programme and one year compulsory clinical posting.

The School held its matriculation of sixty four (64) fresh students for 2022/2023

Patients' admission to short stay ward at Oshodi annex had commenced

1.4.1 Power supply at Oshodi annex

The electric power supply at Oshodi annex has been restored following the damage on the transformer that disrupted power supply for about two (2) weeks at Oshodi annex.

1.5 School of post Basic Psychiatric/Mental Health Nursing

All the students in the 2022/23 academic set are currently doing their clinical posting in nine (9) different locations within the Lagos metropolis. However, the School is awaiting its re-accreditation soon.

1.6 Union Matters

1.6.1 The Medical and Health Workers Union of Nigeria, FAC Lagos in conjunction with DOZY Mmobuosi foundation carried out a free prostate Cancer screening and sugar level/blood pressure checks for members of staff in their mobile clinic.



Two hundred and forty three (243) participants were recorded.

1.6.2 The Senior Staff Association of the Hospital (SSAUTHRIAI) has partnered with Federal Government Housing Loan Board

(FGSLB) and Brooks Assets & Resources Limited on provision of affordable housing for its members. Officials from the two bodies visited the hospital in April for a stakeholders meeting noting that there are different apartment in various locations across Lagos.
